Research Interest

My primary research focus is the application of innovative quantitative methods to substance use and related health data. From a methodological standpoint, I am interested in how to gain the most information from intensive longitudinal designs (ILD) such as daily diary studies, ecological momentary assessments (EMA), and micro randomized trials (MRT). I am interested in utilizing these techniques to address daily and momentary effects on substance use patterns, for example to model moment-to-moment or day-to-day mood states to examine how emotions from a previous occasion can affect the risk of substance use on the next. I also would like to understand how compliance rates and participant burden in intensive longitudinal designs can be affected by design factors, as the use of ILD and EMA has become increasingly prominent in current research. Ultimately, by gaining an understanding of how temporal effects modulate substance use over time, I hope to inform more nuanced momentary-level interventions that target high-risk substance use.
